**Re-designation of KTNF (Roger)**

The KTNF has to be re-designated by Camden Council every four years. This requires 21 people who live and work in the KTNF boundaries to submit names and addresses to back the re-designation. Roger has been in touch with Brian O'Donnell who is keen to get the re-designation process underway.

An email to KTNF members requesting names and addresses was sent mid-February, and 28 people supplied names and addresses, which are being passed on to Camden Council
